You know that I have trouble hearing. But unlike Beethoven* I can use the phone. **The National Relay Service (NRS)** helps me have phone conversations just like anyone else.

Ring me through the NRS on **133 677** and, when asked,

dial my phone number

When the relay officer comes on the line talk to them just as if you were talking to me.

You can ring me anytime from anywhere in Australia. The call won't cost any extra and our privacy is protected by law.
